and drilled to a depth of 3366' finding no show of oil. The 10-3/4" casing was set at 211' and cemented with 200 sk. of cement. This pipe will not be pulled. The 7" casing was set at 3298' and cemented with 250 sk. of cement, the recoverable part of the 7" casing will be pulled.
