This letter is a request by Cambrian Oil Corp. to amend the surface casing requirement on the above referenced well. This request comes after several conversations with Jeff Clock from your office. It appears there was some confusion as to well names and numbers by Nebraska Drilling, the contractor on all three wells drilled in this area. The Ochsner "A" #1 And the Ochsner "B" #1 had two different sets of surface casing requirements but were done properly. The Clark "A" #1 was drilled directly after the Ochsner "B" #1 and the surface casing set was about the same as was required on the Ochsner "B" #1. It appears to me to be a simple mix up in what was actually required on the Clark "A" #1.

Since this has been brought to my attention I have been in contact with the land owner Mr. Dean Clark and the surrounding land owners to determine what the depth of fresh water is in the area. There have been no fresh water zones found above 500 feet in this general area. Mr. Clarks water is piped in from over 2 miles away.

Cambrian Oil Corp. understands the Conservation Divisions concern in maintaining the integrety of all fresh water reservoirs and has and will continue to comply will all requirements by the Conservation Division. This appears to have been a communication problem. There does not appear to be a problem with fresh water at this location with the surface casing which has been cemented in the Clark "A" #1. Again, Cambrian Oil Corp. requests the allowance of the present surface casing as being sufficient in the Clark "A" #1. Thank you for your help in this matter
