KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

JAMES E. RUSSELL PETROLEUM, INC., mailing address at P.O. Box 2618, Abilene, Texas 79604 (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNOR"), for a good and valuable consideration paid to it (the receipt and adequacy of such consideration being acknowledged) by SPLANE OIL, INC., whose address is P.O. Box 386, Chanute, Kansas 66720 (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNEE"), has BARGAINED, SOLD, GRANTED, TRANSFERRED, ASSIGNED and CONVEYED, and does by these presents BARGAIN, SELL, GRANT, TRANSFER, ASSIGN and CONVEY unto ASSIGNEE all of ASSIGNOR'S right, title and interest in and to those certain oil, gas and mineral leases described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and all right, title and interest in and to the leasehold estate and in the machinery and equipment located thereon and used in connection with the production of hydrocarbons from said leases, INsofar as said leases cover the lands above and in said leases described, but saving and excepting an overriding royalty interest of .00807292 of all hydrocarbons produced and sold from said properties, it being understood that such overriding royalty interests are free and clear of all costs of drilling, production and operation.

The James E. Russell Petroleum, Inc. interest conveyed herein is understood to represent a .66666666 working interest which has a net revenue interest of .57916670.

It is understood, however, that this Conveyance is made by ASSIGNOR and accepted by ASSIGNEE subject to all outstanding overriding royalty interests and the interest conveyed herein will bear its proportionate part of such outstanding interests. It is further understood that all overriding royalty interests do not exceed a net revenue burden of .02500000, including the overriding royalty interest reserved above.



PEINE LEASE: Oil and Gas Lease dated June 28, 1980, executed by and between Edward F. Peine as Lessor and James E. Russell Petroleum, Inc., as Lessee recorded in Book 13 Oil & Gas Lease Records, page 207, Anderson County, Kansas, insofar as it covers the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) less 36.5 acres in the Southeast (SE) corner and 11.25 acres in the Northeast (NE) corner: and the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) less road of Section Four (4), Township Twenty-Three (23) South, Range nineteen (19) East, Anderson County, Kansas, known as the Edward F. Peine oil and gas lease.
