And for the same consideration, the Assignor covenants with the Assignee, that the Assignor is the lawful owner of and has good title to the interest above assigned in and to said leases, estate, rights and property, free and clear from all liens, encumbrances or adverse claims; that said leases are valid and subsisting leases on the lands above described; and all rentals and royalties due thereunder have been paid and all conditions necessary to keep the same in full force have been duly performed, and that the Assignor will warrant and forever defend the same against all persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.

No recourse shall be had for any claim, payment, obligation, agreement or for any other reason, under any rule of law or equity, statute or constitution, against the agents of the Assignor authorized to execute this Agreement, and any such liability of the agents of the Assignor is hereby expressly waived and released as a condition of and consideration for the execution of this Assignment.

As additional consideration for this assignment, Assignees agree to accept all well-plugging responsibilities and liabilities for all oil and/or gas wells located on the above described tracts of real estate. As further additional consideration for this assignment, Assignors covenant with Assignees that Assignees shall not be required to plug more than 10 oil and/or gas wells per year on the above described tracts of real estate, said covenant to be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the said Assignors.

Assignor Sharon Siegener Trust Dated August 8, 2000 ("the Trust"), a member of the LLC, by and through its successor trustee, Rebecca E. Floyd, states:

a. She is the successor trustee named and designated under a Trust agreement dated August 8, 2000, to which the above referenced oil and gas leases were assigned by Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease to Sharon Siegener Trust Dated 08/08/00, Sharon Siegener, Trustee, recorded on August 30, 2000, @ 11:35am in Book 105 of Records, Page 254.

b. Said Trust was a revocable trust.

c. She is the presently existing successor trustee under said Trust, and any amendments thereto, and she is authorized to assign the Trust's interest in the above referenced oil and gas leases to the Assignees named herein, without any qualification whatsoever.

d. The trust is in existence and she is authorized to transfer the interests in the above referenced oil and gas leases.

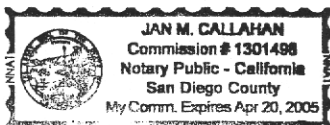
