- 2. Ancillary Rights. Substances in paying quantities, but such well or wells are either shull in or production therefrom is not being sold by Leases, such well or wells shall nevertheless be deemed to be producing in paying quantities for the purpose of maintaining this lease. If fer a period of 50 consecutive days such well or wells are shull in or production therefrom is not sold by Leases, then Leases shall pay an aggregate shull-in repaired the term covered by this lease. The payment shall be made to Leaser on or before the first enrivenessry date of the lease following the end of the 50-day period and therestee on ar before each nontherapy while the well or wells are shull no production therefrom is not being sold by Leases, provided that if this lease is otherwise being meintained by operations under this lease, or if production is being sold by Leases from another well or wells on the leased premises or fundamental posted or unliked therewith, no shut-in royally shall be due until the first anniversary date of the lease following the end of the 90-day period after the end of the period sext following the casestion of such operations or production, as the case may be. Leases's failure to property pay shull-in royally shall render Leases fable for the amount due, but shall not operate to terminate this lease.
- 6. Royalty Payment. For all Oil and Gas Substances that are physically produced from the leased premises, or lands pooled, unitized or communitized therewith, and sold, leaser shall receive as its repairy [15] % of the sales proceeds solvely received by leaser or, if applicable, its affiliate, as a result of the first sale of the affected production to an unaffiliated party, less this same percentage share of all post Production Coate and this same percentage share of all coates of produced production, assertance and at valorance taxes. As used in this provision, Post Production Coates shall meet all posts actually incurred by leaser or its affiliate and all iosses of produced volumes whether by use as fuel, line loss, flering, venting or otherwise from and after the wellness to the point of sale. These coate include without linetation, all coates of gethering, marketing, compression, deliveration, removal of liquid or geneous substances or impurities from the affected production, and any other treatment or processing required by the first unrefitted party who purchases the effected production. For reyalty calculation purposes, lesses shall never be required to adjust the sales proceeds to account for the purchaser's costs or charges dewnetream of the point of sale.

Lessee or its affiliate shall have the right to construct, maintain and operate any facilities providing some or all of the services identified as Post Production Costs. If this cocum, the actual costs of such facilities shall be included in the Post Production Costs as a per barrel or par mot charge, as appropriate, calculated by spreading the construction, maintenance and operating costs for such facilities over the reasonably estimated total production volumes attributable to the well or well using such facilities.

Lesses shall not be lightle for breach of any provisions or implied covenants of this lesses when drilling, production or other operations are so prevented or delayed.
- 13. Breach or Default. No Hitgetion shall be initiated by Lessor for damages, forteiture or cancellation with respect to any breach or default by Lessoe hereunder, for a period of at lesso 90 days after Lessoe falls to remedy the breach or default, and then only if Lessoe falls to remedy the breach or default within such period.
