Article Eleven

Specific Distributions upon Death of Survivor

As soon as practical after the death of the survivor of us, our Trustee shall make the specific distributions identified in this Article from our remaining trust property not distributed under prior Articles of this trust.

Section 11.01 Specific Distribution to Brian L. Specht

As soon as practicable after the death of the survivor of us, our Trustee shall distribute from the remaining trust property all real estate in Woodson and Allen County, Kansas; all mineral interests, both working interests and landowner royalty interests regardless of whether or not such interests relate to production that is on or beneath land included above; all farm and oilfield machinery and equipment, tools, inventory, etc., including the pulling unit; and the Model A automobile, to Brian L. Specht.

If Brian L. Specht is deceased, our Trustee shall distribute this property to Brian L. Specht's descendants, per stirpes.

Death taxes are to be apportioned to the recipient of this distribution, notwithstanding the provisions of Article Five. Property passing under this Section passes subject to all liens, security interests, and other encumbrances.

Section 11.02 Specific Distribution to Michelle M. Dilisio, Lisa Jo Fontaine, Carla A. Mueller, and children of Nancie Lea Wilson, who are Maggie Wilson and Michael Wilson

As soon as practicable after the death of the survivor of us, our Trustee shall distribute from the remaining trust property, after all costs of administration other than any possible estate tax for which the apportionment shall be provided for herein, all investments, life insurance death benefits, all intangible personal property in four equal shares, Maggie Wilson and Michael Wilson are to divide one of such shares, equally.

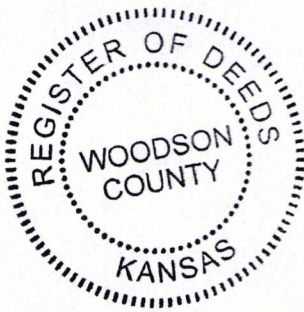
In the event of the death of any named beneficiary, such beneficiary's share shall be distributed to his or her descendants, per stirpes.


