recorded in book 108 Misc., page 681-682 insofar as said lease covers the following described land in Neosho County, State of Kansas:

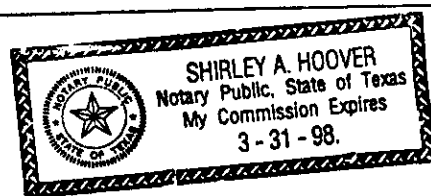
