		<u>Note: This was a pit well located within a concrete pit with dirt and concrete floor. The well casing extended about 12" above pit floor but was about 3' below ground level.</u> <u>The 6" plastic casing was extended to 12" above the concrete slab that makes the roof of the concrete pit. The concrete pit roof is about 12" above normal ground level.</u> <u>A pitless adapter was installed</u>			<u>in the 6" plastic casing. New poly service lines were installed from the pitless adapter to existing yard sprinkler line system and to a house line.</u> <u>An 18" plastic casing was installed around the 6" plastic casing to eliminate contamination source around the 6" casing. This annulus was filled with chlorinated sand, soil and concrete to the roof of the concrete pit - flush with the existing concrete slab. The well casing is 12" above concrete slab.</u>
