To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed is a completed *Water Well Plugging Record* for a water "well" that was completely eradicated during the course of highway construction on K-99 in Elk County. State highway K-99 is being reconstructed from approximately 1 mile south of US-400 to approximately ½ mile north of Howard, KS. The Kansas Department of Transportation's plans called for the "plugging" of five existing water wells along the 10-mile project corridor. The wells are not truly wells, but rock-lined, hand-dug cisterns used for water storage and are being completely be removed via excavation and backfill.
