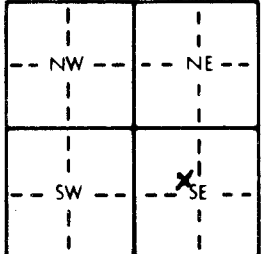

WAS SUCCESSFUL IN REMOVING THE OLD PLUG, AND CERTIFY THAT WELL WAS PLUGGED FAW THE INSTRUCTIONS PROVIDED TO US THAT WE RECEIVED ON 11-15-94. USED FOUR 50 LB BAGS OF BENTONITE, AND ONE TWO 50 LB BAGS OF CONCRETE.
