Dear Mr. Slipke:

A field inspection conducted by this office on April 10, 1989 found the above referenced well(s) to be abandoned. District policies and State of Kansas regulations require that all abandoned water wells be properly disposed of by being permanently plugged, properly capped for use at a later time, or reconstructed and put back in use upon acquisition of all necessary permits, water rights, etc.

YOU SHOULD CONTACT THIS OFFICE BY MARCH 2, 1990 FOR INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PROPERLY DISPOSE OF THE WELL(S) LISTED ABOVE AND TO ARRANGE A TIME FRAME FOR COMPLETION. You will find that the methods described above are quite simple and require little time and expense. This is your chance to resolve a problem without going through needless formalities.

Please be advised that there will not be a second well inspection and your failure to respond to this letter will give the District no choice but to issue a formal Findings and Order requiring immediate proper disposition of the well. Please give this matter your prompt attention. Also, please contact the District office if you feel that you have received this letter in error.
